### Shopping center set for Muirfield Drive

Developers have started tenant improvements for a \$2 million shopping center with an Irish village motif off Muirfield Drive in Dublin. The Shoppes of Athenry, a 26,400-square-foot neighborhood center by developers Donald Kelley and Robert Weiler Jr., was scheduled for dedication May 28. William Andrews Architects of Dublin designed the shopping center while Wallick Construction Co. served as general contractor for the \$2 million contract. Patrick Kelley of Falco Smith & Kelley Co. is the leasing agent. Mary Kelley's, a 7,500-square-foot restaurant anchor to the center, will open in July. Dick and Kathy Hammond, former owners of Hammond's Bar and Grill on Route 161, will operate the family-style restaurant. Dublin Cleaners and Kafe Kanose, a gourmet coffee and pastries shop, are the other two signed tenants. Other tenants expected include a pizza shop, a hair salon, a candy store and a ice cream shop.
